# **Agenda Item Title**

Approve initiation of contract to purchase 2 new Type 1 fire engines to replace 3383 and 3385.

#### **Recommended Actions**

# **Executive Summary**

Engines 3383 and 3385 are due to be replaced within the year. Our apparatus committee has been working diligently to come up with a type one engine spec that is smaller in size, yet will still perform the needed functions of a type one, and be a good fit for Sonoma Valley Fire District. The reason for the smaller size is the location where these engines will be placed and the access challenges we face in their respective response zones. If approved, funds for the purchase of this equipment will be assigned from the District's Capital Equipment Replacement Fund, which has a current balance of \$1.3 million. This purchase would not require financing. Initiating this purchase and prepayment of the cab and chassis will save the District an additional \$19,798. The balance will be paid upon delivery of the engines.

Additionally, we have secured financial commitments from the SVFA (\$75,000) and the GEFA (\$300,000) toward the purchase of these two apparatus.
